# 'Almost oblivious to the pain'.

Jack Nelson uses Tri-Solfen when mulesing his Merinos for its instantaneous pain relief effects.

Jack Nelson has been on the farm his entire life. That farm is Mt Rebecca Agri Co in Cressy, Victoria, a sixth-generation property that spans 3,500 acres.

Amongst a community of sheep grazers, the Nelsons run just over 3,000 pure-bred Merinos, selling stock and wool via Nutrien Ag. They also produce hay, straw and grain, auctioning their harvests to the highest bidder.

#### Championing animal welfare.

Animal welfare has always been high on the priority list for Jack and his family, a focus that has been steadily spreading throughout the industry over the past few years.

"I knew (pain relief) needed to be a process going forward, otherwise there was no chance that the mulesing practice would be able to continue. To sustainably produce anything, it needs to be animal friendly and animal husbandry practices all come into it."
