Nestled in the middle of 'harder country', in Queensland's Maranoa Region, is the small town of Injune with a population of 461 people. Across 9,500 acres, they run 650 Santa Gertrudis breeders, known for their lovely temperament, softness, fertility, ease of calving, and muscle volume. They also run a crossbreeding operation on Yarrabin, 50km north of Roma, where they integrate Charolais, Braford and a few Brangus breeders.

Primarily selling their 300-350kg weaners through the Roma Store Sale, they also target the feedlotter and background markets, and are broaching a little into Auction Plus and getting a Heifer stud up and running.

With the business branching out in so many different directions, raising heavy, healthy and happy calves was imperative.

A lucky find while flicking through Queensland Country Life.
