## Helping to keep weaners calm during dehorning and castration.

#### Tammy Cross considers Tri-Solfen a staple on her property.

John and Tammy Cross manage a 140 000-acre cattle station in Queensland near Ravenswood, a small township 130km south-west of Townsville.
